Lakes Winter Closure

The lakes may be closed each year for an extended period to allow the fish to have a break & also for maintenance to be carried out. We publish the exact dates on our website & social media in advance.

Children

Please ensure that all children are supervised at all times. HBL is a large family oriented site & whilst we encourage everyone to enjoy all our facilities, children must be fully supervised at all times, to avoid inherent dangers. Particular dangers apply to traffic movements, open water, play areas & open fires/bbqs. Please ensure children do not use any play equipment after dusk.

FORCE MAJEURE

HBL cannot accept, be responsible for, or liable in respect of loss, damage or changes caused by force majeure, e.g. strikes, riots, political unrest, war or threat of war, terrorist activities, industrial disputes, fire, flood, closure of airports, weather conditions or other events beyond our control.

SITE MANAGEMENT RULES

• **Dip keep & landing nets**

- Use landing mats/nets at all times.
- No leadcore or unleaded leadcore or leadcore alternatives. (safezone style leaders and tubing can be used as an alternative).
- No braided mainline or shock leaders.
- No spodding, no spinning, no lures.
- Maximum mainline breaking strain 20lbs.
- Keep nets are not permitted except for prior arranged matches.
- No wading or swimming in lakes.
- No rods to be left unattended in the water.
- You must not stand up and hold fish for photographing. The fish must be held as close to the ground and unhooking mat as possible and returned to the lake inside a sling or mat.
- Do not obstruct footpaths with shelters/bivvies, access is required across the fishery at all times.
- It is an offence to remove or introduce fish to these waters. anyone found killing fish and/or removing fish will be prosecuted.
- All litter to be removed from swims. Persistent offenders will not be welcome at the HBL fishery. Please use litter bins provided. In the unlikely event that we do find litter on your swim we will contact you and advise accordingly.
- Park in designated areas only. No parking in passing bays.
- Fish only from swim platforms.
- Use barbless hooks only.
- Maximum size 6 hooks.
- No trout pellets, boat bait or floating baits.
- Return all fish immediately (except agreed match fish).
- Do not return crayfish to water (EA Regulation).
- No tents, only fishing shelter, i.e bivvy or umbrella overwraps.
- Please give up disabled platforms if required.
- Dogs on leads only.
- Beware overhead cables and walkers to footpaths.
- No audio equipment except used with earpiece.
- No fires/firepits or bbqs allowed to be used, please use either gas or primus stoves.
- 5mph speed limit on site.
- No vehicles to drive on grass to swims.
- Bank sticks that are driven into the ground are not allowed on any lake.
